PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

WITHIN 25-MILE RADIUS OF THE NATIONAL THEATRE

- 1321 Pennsylvania Ave, NW, Washington, DC
- In the most direct driving route

PRODUCE A FULLY-STAGED, FULL-LEGTH MUSICAL THEATRE PRODUCTION

Concert versions and Broadway Junior scripts are not allowed

PRODUCTION MUST APPEAR ON THE JIMMY AWARDS APPROVED LIST

Full list and explanations are found at <u>JimmyAwards.com</u>

PERFORMED BETWEEN OCTOBER 15, 2022 and MAY 7, 2023

• To keep up with the schedule required for the Awards Ceremony



WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE YOUR PRODUCTION

APPLICATION

PARTICIPATION FEE

- Each school must pay \$200 participation fee to complete the application
- A waiver may be requested by emailing info@brandonvictordixonawards.com

PERFORMANCE DETAILS FORM

- No later than 3 weeks before your performance date
- This informs the ballot for the judges (performer names, design elements, etc)

RESERVE SEATS FOR JUDGES

- Each show will be seen by at least 3 judges
- The school will be expected to reserve 2 seats per judge.
- The assigned performance dates will be sent to the school contact no later than 1 week before the evaluated performance date



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR PRODUCTION

YOU DO YOUR SHOW

- And it is WONDERFUL!
- Take an 'archive copy' of the production, should you be nominated for Best Musical, the judges may need to review it.

JUDGES ATTEND

Reserve tickets for the judges but please do not reserve seats for them

JUDGES FILL OUT THEIR BALLOTS

- They will go off the information from the Performance Details Form and are asked to cross reference it with the program/house board for accuracy
- If you are double casting your show, note that all judges must see the same cast only list the dates that cast will perform and alert BVDA if casting changes.



WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOUR PRODUCTION

ANNOUNCE NOMINATIONS

- May 12, 2023
- Top 10 performers in Best Actress and Best Actor
- Top 5 Best Musicals

ROUND II JUDGING

- May 22, 2023
- Actor and Actress nominees will perform a contrasting piece for a panel of judges
- Best Musicals will have a "second look" based on the archive video of the production ANNOUNCE TOP 5
- May 23, 2023

SPECIAL PROGRAMMING & JIMMY AWARDS PREP

- May 30– June 2, 2023
- Preparing the content for the Jimmy Awards



THE AWARD CEREMONY JUNE 3, 2023

ALL PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS

- All participating schools are invited to send production photos of their evaluated performance to be included in the video projections during the Awards Ceremony.
- All participating schools are invited to select 2 students to perform in the Opening Number of the Awards Ceremony.

FINALISTS PERFORM DURING THE CEREMONY

- Top 5 Best Actress and Best Actor finalists perform a solo or duet from the original show
- Top 5 Best Musicals perform a 5-minute or less musical number

WINNERS

- Best Musical gets money for the school's theatre program and a plaque
- Best Actress and Actor get a scholarship and expenses paid trip to the Jimmy Awards week to compete for the National title
